

WEYBRIDGE ROWING CLUB CLUB RULES FOR JUNIORS

Weybridge Rowing Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Welfare Officer, whose name and telephone number are displayed on the Club Noticeboard and on the website.

The following junior club rules are supplementary to the Rules of Weybridge Rowing Club. A junior is defined as a person who has not yet attained the age of 18 years.

- 1. Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach if they are going to be late.
- 2. Members must wear suitable kit for training appropriate for the weather conditions and as agreed with their coach. Club colours must be worn for competitions.
- 3. Members must pay any fees for regattas or other events promptly.
- 4. All members must abide by the BR Rules of Racing and respect officials and their decisions.
- 5. All members must respect opponents. Unsportsmanlike behaviour, such as wilful interference while competing, foul language and rough play will not be tolerated.
- 6. Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- 7. Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
